Question 31 Worksheet

Has the student ever been convicted of possessing or selling **illegal drugs**?

A federal law suspends federal student aid eligibility for students convicted under federal or state law of possession or sale of drugs (not including alcohol and tobacco). If the answer to this question is "Yes", the Question 31 Worksheet will help determine whether this law affects the student's eligibility for federal student aid.

Count only federal or state convictions. **Do not count** convictions that have been removed from the student's record. **Do not count** convictions that occurred before the student turned 18, unless the student was tried as an adult.

- 7-10 days after submission - if you printed, signed and mailed a signature page.

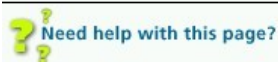
