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## Community Resource Inventory

Use the Community Resource Inventory to identify and record information about resources that are already available in your community. Separate lists can be constructed for:

- Existing programs that provide services to youth who may be at risk and/or to their families.
- Potential financial resources, both public and private, that could be used to support your initiative.
- Individual citizens or businesses that have an interest in serving the community.
- Businesses, schools, churches, hospitals, and universities that could support the partnership with services, logistics, finances, or personnel.

Many communities have existing resource directories, grant listings, governmental directories, or other similar sources that can assist you in determining what organizations might be of assistance. Key informants with in-depth knowledge of the area targeted in your community partnership can also help identify resources.
