Estimates for the Other School Staff Survey are based on 10 respondents at each of 72 schools.

<sup>b</sup>Estimates differ for fall and spring since teachers will complete the entire survey in the fall of the third grade, the fall of the fourth grade, and the spring of the fifth grade. In the spring of the third grade and spring of the fourth grade, they will simply update the professional development information they provided in the previous wave.
