DTIC's Products and Services

- **Research and Engineering (R&E) Portal** is available to Department of Defense (DoD) and Federal Government employees/contractors. The R&E Portal will be the focal point for obtaining information on research and engineering activities within DoD. It brings together, with a single sign-on, the strategic planning documents, financial databases, congressional information and more. - **Private Scientific and Technical Information Network (STINET)** is an online service that provides convenient accessibility to DTIC's databases, including full-text documents available right from your desktop. Private STINET will be available to you within one business day following approval of your registration. The URL to access Private STINET is: <https://dtic-stinet.dtic.mil>.

When prompted, enter your User ID _____ and the password you created during your online registration. Note: If you do not remember or know your password, click the cancel button in the Private STINET login dialog box. At the next screen click on the "reset password" link.

- **Information Analysis Centers (IACs)** are research organizations chartered by DoD and sponsored by DTIC.
