

Changes Made to the Updated Form I-9 (May 30, 2007)

- Removed five documents from and added one document to List A to bring the Form I-9 in compliance with an interim rule published in 1997 (8 CFR Part 274a)
 - **Documents removed:** Certificate of U.S. Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization, Form I-151, Unexpired Reentry Permit, Unexpired Refugee Travel Document
 - **Document added:** I-766, Employment Authorization Document
- Remaining documents on List A re-worded and re-numbered to match the wording and order given in the regulation
- Added statement in first paragraph under “Filling Out the Form I-9” that informs employees that providing the SSN on the Form I-9 is optional unless their employer participates in the Employment Eligibility Program. Providing the SSN has always been optional, but that was not stated on the previous Form I-9 as it should have been.
- Changed font and format of the Form I-9 to make it easier to read
- Reorganized the information on the Form i-9 to give it a more logical flow and gave it headings that more closely resemble those on other USCIS forms. The sections entitled “What is the Filing Fee?” and “USCIS Forms and Information” are new and were added because the information is helpful to employers and because other USCIS forms include this information.
- Fixed grammar mistakes and typos
- Changed reporting burden under “Paperwork Reduction Act” in accordance with the latest estimates
