To allow access to your secure FAFSA data, we need you to provide the information below. This information must match the personal information you provided in obtaining your PIN. Your PIN serves as your electronic signature and provides access to your application data.

You cannot change your Social Security Number (SSN) using this form. If your SSN is incorrect, you will have to begin a new application.

Create a password so that you can retrieve your information if you do not finish your application in one session. Don't forget the password – our Customer Service does not retain your password.
