# **Academic Competitiveness Grant**

Recent changes in Federal law have created a new student aid grant program called the Academic Competitiveness Grant (ACG). To be eligible for this grant a student must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant
- Be a first or second year undergraduate student
- Have completed a rigorous high school program of study after January 1, 2005
- Be enrolled full-time in a two or four year degree program.

To determine if you may be eligible for an ACG, select "ACG eligiblity".


