## Question 1

The Census Bureau is doing research about questions on the census form you completed earlier this year. At that time, you were asked how many people lived or stayed there on May 1, 2008. You were asked if there were any additional people staying with you on May 1, 2008. You indicated (fill $1^{\text {st }}$ undercount category marked, i.e. a child was staying there, such as a newborn baby or foster child; a relative was staying there, such as adult children, cousins, or in-laws; a non-relative was staying there, for example a roommate or live-in baby sitter; somebody was staying there temporarily) but that person was not included in the number of people you reported.
