When I say "in the past four weeks," I want you to think about the time from [the [BEGINNING/MIDDLE/END] OF MONTH] four weeks ago (when [EVENT ON TIMELINE FOR FOUR WEEKS AGO]) up to and including today (DRAW PARALLEL HORIZONTAL LINE ACROSS SPAN OF "LAST FOUR WEEKS" ON TIMELINE).
