Introduction:

Hi, this is _____ and I am calling from the AABB regarding the 2007 National Blood Collection and Utilization Survey. You should have received your survey packet that we mailed earlier in the summer. It had a bright orange cover. I am calling today to verify that you did receive the survey and to inquire about its status. Have you seen the survey?

As you know, this is a very important survey. It is the <u>ONLY</u> survey of its kind and the only way for HHS to determine the amount of blood that is collected and transfused in the United States, as well as to ascertain the answers to many important questions about the blood supply. Let me assure you the information you provide us will be kept confidential and the data will only be reported in aggregate.

Do you need another copy of the survey? Can we email you a copy?

Do you have any questions about the survey that might be holding you up?

It will only take a little bit of your time and this will give us an accurate picture of the number of units collected and transfused in the United States.
