If you have already established an account you may login now.

You must first establish an account in order to access RRB Internet services. To establish an account, follow steps 1 and 2.

- Go to Box 1 to request a Password Request Code (PRC). A PRC will be sent by US Mail to your address of record.
- Go to Box 2 when you receive your PRC. Use the PRC to establish your PIN/Password account.

Once you receive your PRC and establish your account, you **never** need to click on Box 1 or 2 again. You perform **steps** 1 and 2 only one time. **Go** to Box 3 **for all future** access to our online services.

MOTE: You will not be able to establish an account unless your web browser supports advanced encryption. Some older versions of web <u>browsers</u> are not compatible with the PIN/Password feature.

Request a Password Request Code (PRC)

Obtain a Password Request Code (PRC). A PRC is needed to establish an online account with the RRB.

2 Establish your RRB Internet Account

Establish an RRB Internet account after receiving a PRC in the mail. Once the account is established the PRC is no longer needed.




