- Use inedible almond material only in permitted outlets.
- Obtain from each almond handler an executed ABC Form 8 for each disposition.
- Complete Part (b) of the Form 8 and mail it to the Board along with a weight certificate issued at the time of receipt of inedible material (i.e., destination weight) in a timely fashion.
- Allow Board employees or their designee's access to premises for inspection and audit.

Please return **two** signed originals of the application, ABC Form 34, which is enclosed along with the Data Sheet. Upon approval of your application and completion of any required audit procedures, you will be listed as an Accepted User (for Crop Year 2001-2002 only) and a signed application will be returned to you.
