Questions for Vacant Units

In the American Community Survey, we collect information for units that are identified as vacant. We ask a knowledgeable respondent for answers to some of the housing questions from the ACS CATI/CAPI/TQA instrument, along with a few additional questions.

For vacant units, we ask VACUNIT_CP:

Is this unit...?
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. For rent2. Rented, not occupied3. For sale only4. Sold, not occupied5. For seasonal, recreational or occasional use6. For migrant workers7. Other vacant

We also collect vacancy information for units occupied only by persons who do not meet our two-month residency rule. For these units we ask TEMPSTAT:

<p>Since no one is staying here for more than two months, I will not ask any further questions about the people staying at this unit. However, I will need to ask some basic questions about this housing unit.</p> Is this unit...?
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. For rent2. Rented, not occupied3. For sale only4. Sold, not occupied5. For seasonal, recreational, or occasional use6. For migrant workers7. Other vacant

We also collect the name, title, address, and telephone number of the person who provided the information about the vacant unit:

<p>In order to evaluate the quality of my work, my supervisor may contact you to verify that I am doing my job correctly.</p> May I have your name, address and telephone number?
