2007 INSPIRE Internship Application

The Interdisciplinary National Science Program Incorporating Research and Education Experience (INSPIRE) is designed to motivate underserved and underrepresented students to pursue STEM-related careers.

Program Description:

The INSPIRE internship program is an educational program which will offer current 11th graders an opportunity to work side-by-side with engineers or scientists during a six-week NASA-related STEM experience.

Applicant Requirements:

- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen and 16 years old by the program start date;
- Attend school within a 50 mile radius of a NASA Center:
- The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale;
- If chosen as a finalist, the applicant must be willing to participate in a formal interview as part of the placement process; and
- The applicant must be available to participate in the 6-week internship on a full-time basis.

Applications must be submitted to one of the following NASA Centers. Applicants must live or attend school within a 50 mile radius of the NASA Center they are applying to;
