## INSTRUCTIONS FOR POLAR BEAR FORM

1. Date when tagging takes place.
2. Number from tag attached to the hide.
3. Number from tag attached to the skull.
4. Village where hide and skull are tagged.
5. Estimated age class of polar bear: Adult; Sub Adult, Cub.
6. Sex of animal.
7. How sex of bear was determined.
8. Measure skull with calipers and record length (distance between base of skull and upper front teeth), width (distance between zygomatic arch bones), and total to the nearest 1/16th of an inch.
9. Record if other bears/cubs were present when tagged bear was killed.
10. Record biological specimens collected, preserved and presented to tagger,
11. Record type of transportation used when hunting bear.
12. Record the date when this polar bear was killed; month, day, and year.
13. Enter length of time spent on the hunt.
14. Identify specifically where this polar bear was killed. Record the distance from nearest village, river, bay, or other geographic feature.
15. Enter the GPS coordinates of kill location.
16. Enter any other information that may be important, like the caliber of the rifle, circumstances involving the kill, and any unusual condition or behavior of the polar bear.
17. The tagger signs here.
18. Print the name of the hunter.
19. The hunter or owner signs here.

**After completing certificate, give pink copy to hunter, return white copy to our office, and retain the yellow copy in book for your records.**

# NOTICE

## Paperwork Reduction Act and Privacy Act

In accordance with the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995(44U.S.C. 3501, *et seq.*) and the Privacy Act of 1974(5 U.S.C. 552a), please be advised that:

1. The gathering of information on marine mammals harvested by Alaskan Natives is authorized by :
  - (a) the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 (16.S.C. 1379(i)); and

2. Information requested on this form is mandatory to comply with statutory and regulatory requirements. This information is being collected to monitor the subsistence harvest of polar bear and will be used to obtain essential biological data necessary to manage the species. The collection of this information will also help control the illegal take, trade, and transport of specified raw marine mammal parts. Response is not required unless a currently valid Office of Management and Budget(OMB) control number is displayed. The control number for this form is 1018-0066.
3. Routine use disclosures may be made:
  - (a) To the U.S. Dept. of Justice when related to litigation or anticipated litigation;
  - (b) Of information indicating a violation or potential violation of a statute, regulation, rule, order or license to appropriate Federal, State, local or foreign agencies responsible for investigation or prosecuting the violation or for enforcing or implementing the statute, rule, regulation, order or license;
  - (c) From the record of an individual in response to an inquiry from a Congressional office made at the request of that individual(42 FR 1903; April 11, 1977)
4. All names will be removed when we compile results, and only summary information will be reported.
5. The relevant burden to report information required on this form and have the specified parts marked or tagged is 15 minutes.
