Your school has been selected as one of 2,000 schools to participate in a major national study of service-learning in public K-12 schools conducted by the Corporation for National and Community Service. In **[March]**, your superintendent received an advance letter (enclosed) and an advance copy of the survey.

The current survey is a follow-up to studies conducted in 1999 and again in 2004 to determine the extent to which public schools are engaging their students in service-learning activities. The findings from 2004 demonstrated that 30% of K-12 public schools had formal service-learning, and 69% of K-12 public schools involved their students in community service projects. These findings were similar to 1999. The current study will examine trends in these important endeavors.
