Informed Consent Script: Sub-State EMS Region Respondent

Purpose. The purpose of this study is to gain a better understanding of the capabilities and distribution of pre-hospital heart attack and stroke care provided by local EMS responders. The purpose of the interview with you is to get a description of the function and activities of this sub-state EMS region in relation to local providers and state level authorities, and to activities related to pre-hospital EMS practices for heart attack and stroke. The interview will take about 45 minutes. This is not an evaluation.

How the Study is Being Conducted. You will not be quoted by name, nor will statements be attributed to you by name. The notes from the interview will be treated in a confidential manner as follows: Only the identification number assigned to this interview will appear on notes from this interview. The list of respondent names associated with interview identification numbers will be kept in a separate location from interview notes and accessible only to project staff. However, the final report will indicate the states and specific regions that were included in the study which is information that may make it possible for others to guess the source of the information.
