#### Introduction

[Interviewer waits for verbal acknowledgment]. You have given your permission for me to tape record your interview today and, if needed, to play it to other people working on this study. Is that correct? [Interviewer waits for verbal acknowledgment].

I have in front of me questions from a larger survey about gender and behaviors that can put people at risk for contracting HIV, the virus that causes AIDS. Some of the questions are very personal—for example, some questions are about sexual activities, number of sexual partners, and the use of silicone and hormones. There are also some questions on networking – strategies for finding eligible participants. The final survey, including some of the questions I would like to ask you, will be used with people who were born male but identify, live, act, or consider themselves to be a woman. Before interviewers begin to use the survey with more people, we need to test the questions. This interview with you will help us find out if the questions are difficult to answer and whether or not they make sense to people.

First, I want to read the questions to you and have you answer them. It is important that I ask all of these questions, but you don't have to answer specific questions that you do not want to answer. I want to remind you that this interview is strictly confidential. Confidential means that your name will never be linked to the answers you give. When we write a report, we will not put your name in it.

After we finish with the questions in the survey, I will ask you some follow-up questions about how you decided your answers and how you interpreted certain words. I will also ask you if there were any questions that were not easy to understand and how you think we could change the questions so more people will understand them.

Do you have any questions you want to ask me before we begin?

Can you please say that you have received everything for the tape recorder? [Wait for acknowledgement]. Again, thank you for all of your assistance today. [Turn off audio tape recorder at this time]. [Escort respondent out of the RTI interviewing room].

**INTERVIEWER NOTE:** Once the interview has concluded and the respondent has left the interviewing room, the audiotape, consent form and the modified participant data collection sheet will be turned over to an NCHS staff person.
