For the 2008 Tribal NIMS collection, the questions are identical to the 2008 Local NIMS collection with one exception. The following two questions are added to the Tribal collection and they are numbered 6.1 and 6.2. The questions for both the 2008 Local and Tribal collections are numbered exactly the same prior to questions 6.1 and 6.2 in the Tribal collection and after this the questions in the Tribal collection will be one higher than the corresponding question in the Local collection.
