ORIGINAL (white copy) must be mailed to the Calif. Date Admin. Committee, P.O. Box 1736, Indio, CA 92202-1736.
DUPLICATE (canary copy) and **TRIPLICATE** (pink copy) must be given to the party receiving the fruit. Upon arrival at destination the party transporting the fruit must turn both copies over to the party actually receiving the fruit, whereupon said party shall complete the Manufacturer section and mail the pink copy to the CDAC. The canary copy is to be retained by the Manufacturer for record keeping.
QUADRUPLICATE (goldenrod copy) to be retained by Handler authorizing movement of the fruit from its source for record keeping.

The making of any false statements or representations in any matter within the jurisdiction of any agency of the United States, knowing it to be false, is a violation of title 18, Section 1001, United States Code, which provides for a penalty of a fine of \$10,000 or imprisonment of not more than five years or both.

This report is required by law (7 USC 608(d), 7 CFR 987.64, 7 CFR 987.151). Failure to report can result in a fine of not less than \$50 or more than \$5,000 for each such violation and each day during which such violation continues shall be deemed a separate violation. This form is to insure proper disposition of product grade dates.
