An authorized officer or employee of a corporate producer; or an administrator, executor, or trustee of a producing estate or any other business unit is eligible to cast one vote on behalf of such producing business entity. "PRODUCER" means an individual, partnership, corporation, association, or any other business unit who:

A. Owns and farms land, resulting in ownership of the almonds produced thereon;

B. Rents and farms land, resulting in ownership of all or a portion of the almonds produced thereon;

C. Owns land which he or she does not farm and, as rental for such land, obtains ownership for a portion of the almonds produced thereon.
