The new verbiage instructs petitioners to file directly with the Service Center that will be adjudicating the petitions and will eliminate the need to forward files from the Nebraska and Texas Service Centers.

**Change #2** – Guam residents must file with the California Service Center. U.S. Virgin Islands residents must file with the Vermont Service Center. The new verbiage is in line with the remittance instructions in 8 CFR §103.7(a)(2).
