1. Scope of survey

This survey covers public warehouses holding cotton.

Report stocks of cotton in your possession at this establishment at the close of business of the day indicated regardless of the year or locality of growth. Your figures should include cotton -

On hand for which you have not issued warehouse receipts (including transit bales under your control).

Held for the account of the Commodity Credit Corporation

but exclude cotton -

In transit to or from your warehouse not under your control.

Stocks of cotton and linters waste, motes, etc.

Units of measure

Report in the unit of measure specified for each item.

Convert foreign cotton to 500 pounds equivalent gross weight bales by dividing the total weight including baling materials by 500, or the net weight of the cotton excluding baling materials by 480.

3. Definitions

American Upland cotton includes both rain grown and irrigated. Do not assume that all irrigated and/or roller ginned cotton is extra long staple.
