## 12. Estimate of the hour burden of the collection of information:

It is estimated that it will take 10 minutes for respondents to respond to the survey. A total not to exceed 1,000 surveys will be mailed out with an expected $40 \%$ to be returned (400). The number of respondents $=400 \times 10$ minutes to respond to survey $=$ 4,000 burden minutes, divided by 60 minutes $=66$ hours with each iteration estimated to occur annually. It is estimated that there will be two focus groups at 4 facilities to occur annually. Each focus group will be one hour in length and 10 participates per focus group, given a total of 80 participates. The number of participants $=80 \times 60$ minutes, divided by 60 to respond to focus group questions $=80$ burden hours. The total burden hours for the surveys and focus group would be 146.
