- Purpose. To publish information about the 30th MCM and to solicit appointments of Special Project Officers (SPO) to augment MCM Operations.
- 2. Background. The MCM is the Marine Corps' largest annual community relation's event. The MCM promotes physical fitness, directs the public's attention to the Marine Corps, and promotes a spirit of community involvement. This race is ranked as one of the largest marathons in the country and is known for its exceptional organization. The reference provides operational guidance for project officers. Enclosure (1) outlines task organization for planning, coordination, and execution of assigned missions. Enclosure (2) identifies historical personnel support and forges an agreement with the MCM and additional units to provide assistance.

3. Information

- a. The 30th MCM will be held on 30 October 2005. The registration of 30,000 runners will produce 25,000 participants on race day. Other events associated with the MCM are:
- Runner's Exposition and Packet Pickup at the DC Armory, Washington, DC on 28-29 October 2005 at 0900;
- (2) Healthy Kids' Fun Run at the Iwo Jima Monument on 30 October 2005 at 0905;
- (3) MCM 8K and the Annual Special Olympics Competition at the Iwo Jima Monument on 30 October 2005 at 8925; and

- (4) Associated MCM events are outlined in annex EE (Special Events) of the reference and include support to the Armed Forces Marathon Competition, Challenge Cup Competition, Hall of Fame Presentations, and other events as scheduled by the command.
- b. The Comdr MCB is responsible for the overall conduct of the marathon. The Director, MCM is responsible for the planning and execution of the marathon. The point of contact for day-to-day operations of the marathon is the Operations Coordinator, Bret Schmidt at 703-432-1160, Building 3399.
- c. The Director of the MCM functions under the staff cognizance of the Comdr MCB.
