

2009 AHS Disability Questions

For the 2009, we will add a module of disability questions to the AHS. The questions are as follows:

With this next set of questions, we want to learn about people who have physical, mental or emotional conditions that cause serious difficulty with their daily activities. [Though different, these questions may sound similar to ones I asked earlier.]

(DSB0_DSBINTRO)

Is anyone in this household deaf or do they have serious difficulty hearing?

(DSB1a_HEARING)

Who is that? Anyone else? **(DSB1b_HEARDIFF)**

Is anyone in this household blind or do they have serious difficulty seeing, even when wearing glasses? **(DSB2a_SEEING)**

Who is that? Anyone else? **(DSB2b_SEEDIFF)**

Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition, does anyone in this household have serious difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions?

(DSB3a_MEMRY)

Who is that? Anyone else? **(DSB3b_MEMDIFF)**

Does anyone in this household have serious difficulty walking or climbing stairs?

(DSB4a_WALKING)

Who is that? Anyone else? **(DSB4b_WALKDIFF)**

Does anyone in this household have serious difficulty dressing or bathing?

(DSB5a_SELFCARE)

Who is that? Anyone else? **(DSB5b_CAREDIFF)**

Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition, does anyone in this household have difficulty doing errands alone such as visiting a doctor's office or shopping?

(DSB6a_ERRANDS)

Who is that? Anyone else? **(DSB6b_ERRNDIFF)**
