The Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) has embarked on a project to develop a comprehensive inventory of all outpatient health care data collection initiatives. AHRQ is particularly interested in determining the availability of regularly collected administrative and other data collection initiatives about outpatient health service utilization. The major objective of this interest is to better understand issues in developing data collection initiatives, redundancies in these initiatives, uses of available data, gaps in available information, similarities across data projects, and areas for possible collaboration and coordination.
