- Item 1b: Report as "WAREHOUSE STOCKS" all domestic hops which you OWN and have in country or terminal warehouses. Include any hops which you have contracted to sell but to which you still retain title.
- Item 1c: Report as stocks "IN TRANSIT" all domestic hops being shipped to brewers or dealers to which you still retain title during period of transit.
