I must notify the Agency in writing of any report all fires to the Agency. changes in the original proposal and have Agency approval in writing for the changes before proceeding with them. Stacking sourcepoints to avoid sensitive resources or areas does not require prior Agency approval. This NOI expires on _ lands involved. the Agency extends it in writing before that date. I understand that this NOI does not grant any exclusive right to the described lands for geophysical exploration, or other purposes. The land area described above is at all times subject to any other lawful uses by the United States, its lessees, permittees. licensees, and assigns.

- I must indemnify the United States for any liability for damage to life or property resulting from the occupancy or use of public lands under the NOI.

- I must take all reasonable precautions to prevent and must suppress fires. The Agency may specify in writing the fire prevention and firefighting equipment I need. At my expense, I must extinguish all fires set or caused as a result of operations under this NOI and must
- I must diligently protect from unnecessary damage United States land and property covered by this NOI. I must pay the United States for any damage resulting from my or my agents' or employees' violation of the terms of this NOI or any law or regulation applicable to the

- I must complete shothole plugging under Agency guidelines and the guidelines of any other local, Federal or State regulatory authority.
- 13. I must remove all materials and equipment I placed on the premises and restore the site to the Agency's satisfaction immediately after I complete the project unless the Agency approves other arrangements.
- 14. I must file a Notice of Completion (NOC) Form within 30 days after completing operations and reclamation. If the location of the project is different from that in the approved NOI, I must submit a revised map with the NOC (1:24,000 scale, where available), including source points.
