Additional Conditions of the Permit:

- This permit allows you to take the species listed on this permit for other subsistence users. You may take up to their harvest limit of this species ON FEDERAL LANDS ONLY; however, you may not have more harvest limits in possession than is allowed by regulations specific to the unit. You and the persons you hunt for must be Federally eligible to hunt as subsistence hunters for this species in the unit/area where you hunt. Check Federal Regulations booklet for eligibility.
- You must have your hunting license, this permit, the other persons' hunting license number(s) and their harvest ticket(s) or registration permit(s) in your possession while hunting or transporting animals taken for them; You must show these to any person authorized to enforce Federal law who requests to see them.
- You must send in a completed hunt report form (issued with this permit) within 15 days after the close of the hunting season.
- You must comply with any additional hunt requirements that may be provided by the officer/agent who issued this permit.

Management is particularly important now because of increasing environmental changes and increasing numbers of people in rural areas.

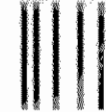
Harvest information is a tool that can be used to help understand and maintain healthy wildlife populations.

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In accordance with the Privacy Act (5 U.S.C. 552a) and the Paperwork Reduction Act (44 U.S.C. 3501), please note the following information. This information collection is authorized by the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act and associated regulations. The Federal Subsistence Board will use this information to manage fish and wildlife resources for subsistence uses. It is our policy not to use your name for any other purpose. We will maintain this information in accordance with the Privacy Act. Your response is voluntary, but is required to obtain or retain a benefit. We may not conduct or sponsor and you are not required to respond to an information collection unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number. OMB has approved this information collection and assigned OMB Control No. 1018-0075. We estimate it will take you about 15 minutes to complete the application and record your harvest. This burden estimate includes time for reviewing instructions, gathering data, and completing and reviewing the form.
