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The variables described in this document parallel the PNDP Common Data Elements.

Missing values should be coded as follows, according to whether the variable has a length of 1, 2, or 3 digits, or is a date. Because these values apply to all variables, the values are not included in the variable ranges listed in the following dictionary.

7 or 97 or 997 or 9997 or 1/1/9997	Temporary missing . These are data that are not available at the time of upload, but that may become available in the next quarter.				
8 or 98 or 998 or 9998 or 1/1/9998	Respondent refused or does not know . These are data that will not be recovered due to patient refusal.				
9 or 99 or 999 or 9999 or 1/1/9999	Final missing . These are data for which no additional recovery effort will be expended; the patient has completed treatment or is out of area.				

In order to facilitate review, revisions to the data dictionary have been highlighted. The Program Status variables have been moved from the Tracking Log Table to the Patient Table.
