## ATTACHMENT 8: GENERATOR OWNERS CONSENT FORM

Introduction: Thank you for agreeing to be in our discussion about generator safety. Through such discussions, we hope to learn the information needs of people related to generator safety. You can refuse to be in the group or drop out at any time. We will ask everyone in the group to keep your identify private, but we cannot be sure that this information will be kept private.

**Benefits:** Your comments will help CDC develop education materials and improve generator safety. If you have any questions on generator safety at the conclusion of our discussion, we will have an expert available to help answer those questions.
