Sampling approach for Matter of Balance

Based on the participant data from Seattle Senior Services period, there were 967 participants during the March 2008-Feb 2009.

To complete 425 surveys, we will need to select a sample of 500 participants (85% completion rate), which is equal to 52% of the total participant population.

The collection process for these 500 surveys will employ the following approach:

- 1. The total participant level, defined as those attending 5+ classes, will be calculated for a one year period across each state.
- 2. That total participant level will represent the proportion of surveys required for that state. For example, if Ohio represents 36% of the Matter of Balance participants, then the survey sample for Ohio will be $.36 \times 500$ or 180 participants. With an assumed completion rate of 85%, this will equate to 153 completed interviews.
- 3. State surveys will be distributed to the first set of participants from Month-1. Collection will be attempted from all participants of Month-1 before moving on to Month-2 participants, and so on. Once the desired number of completed surveys for each state is completed, no further survey requests will be made for that state.
