An authorized officer or employee of a corporate producer; or an administrator, executor, or trustee of a producing estate or any other business unit is eligible to cast one vote on behalf of such producing business entity.

- A. Owns and farms land, resulting in ownership of the almonds produced thereon;
- B. Rents and farms land, resulting in ownership of all or a portion of the almonds produced thereon;
- C. Owns land which he or she does not farm and, as rental for such land, obtains ownership for a portion of the almonds produced thereon.
