Subject: **Justification for Adding People's Garden School Pilot Program Grant to the List of Approved Programs Using Uniform Grant Application for Non-Entitlement Discretionary Grants, OMB Control Number 0584-0512**

The Uniform Grant Application for Non-Entitlement Discretionary Grants, OMB Docket #0584-0512, allows the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) to add programs to the list of approved programs that use this generic clearance process periodically, provided that approval is obtained in advance.

FNS requests OMB approval to add the project People's Garden School Pilot Program Grant to the list of approved projects. This is due to a new grant program authorized under the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1769(g) (3)).

FNS intends to award one grant to eligible entities to develop school garden projects and evaluate the resulting impact on learning outcomes. We are requesting to use 384 hours of the currently approved 31,340 hours for eligible organizations to respond to the Request for Application for the collection of information related to this new grant program, including responding to the request for applications and quarterly and final progress reports.
