Each invoice from the _____ shall display the total project costs for the billing period, separated by U.S. Forest Service and the _____'s share. The final invoice must display the _____'s full match towards the project, as shown in the financial plan, and be submitted no later than 90 days from the expiration date.

2. ADVANCE PAYMENT. The U.S. Forest Service shall make advance payment upon receipt of an invoice from the _____. The invoice must be submitted no more than monthly and the total must not exceed the U.S. Forest Service's share of anticipated expenses as identified on the financial plan. The first invoice may request an advance based on an estimated cost not to exceed 30 days expenditures. Each subsequent invoice must display any additional advance funding for a 30 day period, if needed, as well as the total project costs to date of the invoice, separated by U.S. Forest Service and the _____'s share. In-kind contributions must be displayed as a separate line item and must not be included in the total project costs. If the _____ receive(s) an advance payment and subsequently requests an advance or reimbursement payment, then the request must clearly demonstrate that the previously advanced funds have been fully expended before the U.S. Forest Service can approve the request for payment. Any funds advanced, but not spent, must be returned to the U.S. Forest Service upon expiration of this agreement. The final invoice from the _____ must be submitted no later than 90 days from the expiration date.
