

**Respondent Debriefing Block
August 14, 2009**

Placement: just before the “thank you” screen

block-level universe: all households where status is “COMPLETE”

INTRO:

Ok now I just have a couple of questions about the interview that we just completed.

LTR-1

universe: [inherited from block level]

INTERVIEWER [DO NOT READ]: Did you give THIS RESPONDENT an advance letter?

- Yes → LTR-3
- No → LTR-2
- Don't know / don't remember → BRO-1

LTR-2

universe: LTR-1=no

ASK OR VERIFY

A few weeks ago we mailed a letter to this household explaining the survey. Do you know if you received it?

- Yes → LTR-3
- No → BRO-1
- Don't know / don't remember → BRO-1

LTR-3

universe a: LTR-1=yes

universe b: LTR-2=yes

[fill for universe a: At the beginning of the interview I gave you a letter about the survey. [ASK OR VERIFY] Did you read]

[fill for universe b: Do you recall reading]

the letter, or part of it?

- Yes → LTR-4
- No → BRO-1
- Don't know / don't remember → BRO-1

LTR-4

universe: LTR-3=yes

Did the letter make you more likely to participate in the survey, less likely, or did it have no effect on you?

- More likely to participate
- Less likely to participate
- No effect
- Don't know / don't remember
→ BRO-1

BRO-1

universe: [inherited from block level]

INTERVIEWER [DO NOT READ]: Did you give THIS RESPONDENT a brochure?

- Yes → BRO-2
- No → CAL-1
- Don't know / don't remember → CAL-1

BRO-2

universe: BRO-1=yes

ASK OR VERIFY:

Earlier I gave you a brochure with information about the survey. Did you have a chance to look it over?

- Yes → BRO-3
- No → CAL-1
- Don't know / don't remember → CAL-1

BRO-3

universe: BRO-2=yes

After looking over the brochure did the survey seem more important to you, less important, or neither?

- More important
- Less important
- Neither
- Don't know / don't remember
→ CAL-1

CAL-1

universe: [inherited from block level]

INTERVIEWER [DO NOT READ]: Did you give THIS RESPONDENT a calendar aid?

- Yes → CAL-2
- No → END
- Don't know / don't remember → END

CAL-2

universe: CAL-1=yes

ASK OR VERIFY:

Now I'd like to ask you about the calendar I gave you at the beginning of the interview itself. Did you write anything down on the calendar to help keep track of events, or to remember when certain events occurred?

- Yes → go to CAL-3
- No → go to CAL-3
- Don't know / don't remember → CAL-3

CAL-3

universe: CAL-1=yes

On a scale of 1 to 5, how helpful was the calendar for remembering when any events occurred? One would be very helpful and 5 would be not helpful at all.

- 1. Very helpful

 - 5. Not helpful at all
