

The amending document includes the data security language that has been added to NCES contracts for the survey sample tracing/locating vendors. NCES has revised the Master Service Agreements for outside vendors used by contractors to update locating information on study sample members, including the appropriate language regarding the safeguarding of personally identifying information of these individuals. NPSAS 2008 is being conducted to meet the continuing need for national-level data about significant financial aid issues for students enrolling in postsecondary education. Information about financial aid policies and postsecondary affordability is critical to policymakers who determine the need analysis formulas for Pell Grants, maximum amounts for student loans, and other need-based federal programs.</p>
