B. Collection of Information Employing Statistical Methods

1. <u>Universe and Respondent Selection</u>

The mailing list for the COS is derived from the BR. The COS sample will be drawn from this list which consists of all known multi and single-establishment companies.

2. <u>Sampling Procedures</u>

The mailing list for the COS consists of a certainty component including all multi-establishment companies with 250 or more employees. In addition, a sample of multi-establishment companies with administrative data values that substantially exceed normal industry values are included. We expect these companies to often have organizational changes such as new establishments, closed/sold establishments, change to industry classification, or changes to Federal EIN. A non-certainty component of multi-establishment companies are drawn by industry and size.

3. <u>Maximize response rate and non-response</u>

There will be three mail follow-ups plus selected telephone calls to large companies. This has provided an adequate response rate for past surveys. The response rate in previous years has exceeded 84 percent.

4. <u>Testing Procedures</u>

No other test of procedures has been conducted because the methodology is very similar to what has been used successfully since 1973.
