Pursuant to Office of Management and Budget (OMB) procedures established at 5 CFR Part 1320, <u>Controlling Paperwork Burdens on the Public</u>, I ask that the following collection of information, "Consumer Assistance to Recycled and Save (CARS) Program, CARS Dealer Survey," be processed pursuant to section 1320.13 <u>Emergency processing</u>.

I have determined that this information must be collected prior to the expiration of time periods established under Part 1320, and that this information is essential to NHTSA's mission to implement this Program so that we may conduct a poll of motor vehicle dealers to determine the extent to which the dealers have not yet put into NHTSA's payment system (known as the CARS Invoice Entry web site), mandatory information about sales transactions under the CARS Program.
