"Marketing and training targeting individuals and families regarding the availability of supported employment.

"Collaboration with other state agencies and private entities to tailor services to meet the needs of those individuals experiencing the most significant disabilities. This collaboration includes the provision of supported employment services utilizing waiver funds to provide employment supports to consumers who are unable to continue working without ongoing on site support.

The Department of Rehabilitation Services also provides a Supported Employment Specialist to monitor providers of supported employment services and provide training and technical assistance when needed. Each supported employment provider operates under an outcome based program of services to ensure quality services and appropriate employment options based on individual choice. Each consumer is offered the opportunity to participate in community based assessments to facilitate an informed decision regarding their employment goal. Job development is provided on an individual basis to locate potential jobs based on that person's interests, skills, limitations and community living needs. Job coaching is also provided at the work site to ensure that the individual has the necessary training and skills to work independently. Once the consumer is working independently, extended services are planned and implemented to protect the long term success of the job. Consumer and employer satisfaction regarding the services provided are measured at the time of employment and again before case closure.
