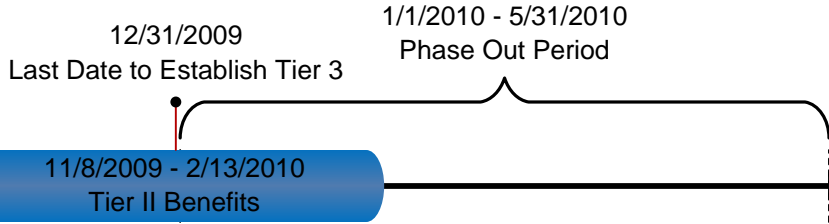


EUC Scenarios

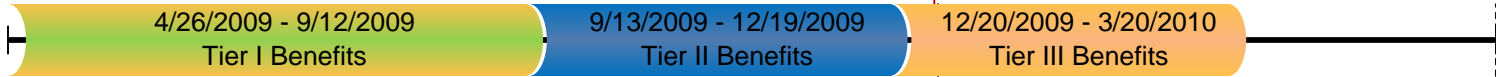
Scenario 1—Claimant receives 20 weeks of Tier I, files Tier II effective 11/8/09 and collects 14 weeks Tier II, exhausting 2/13/10. Not eligible for Tier III.

Scenario 2—Claimant receives 20 weeks of Tier I, files Tier II effective 9/13/09 and collects 14 weeks Tier II, exhausting 12/19/2009. Claimant is eligible for 13 weeks of Tier III. Not eligible for Tier IV.

Scenario 3—Claimant receives 20 weeks of Tier I, files Tier II effective 3/22/09 and collects 13 weeks Tier II, exhausting 10/31/2009. Claimant receives 13 weeks EB, exhausting 1/30/10. Week 14 of Tier II Benefits paid week-ending 2/6/10. Claimant is entitled to Tier III benefits. Not eligible for Tier IV.

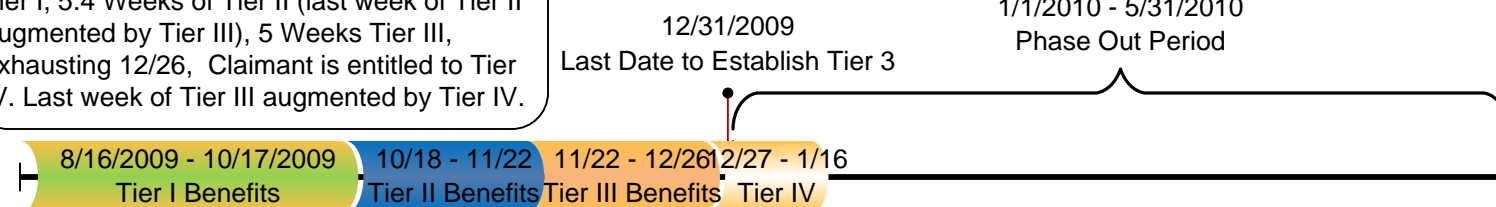
Scenario 4—Claimant receives 20 weeks of Tier I, files Tier II effective 6/21/09 and collects 13 weeks Tier 2, exhausting 9/19/2009. Claimant receives 13 weeks EB. Week 14 of Tier II Benefits paid week-ending 12/26/09. Claimant is entitled to Tier III benefits. Not eligible for Tier IV.

Scenario 5—Claimant has UI claim of 10 weeks duration. Claimant receives 8 Weeks of Tier I, 5.4 Weeks of Tier II (last week of Tier II augmented by Tier III), 5 Weeks Tier III, exhausting 12/26, Claimant is entitled to Tier IV. Last week of Tier III augmented by Tier IV.
