

E-Notification

If you are filing your Form I-601 at one of the USCIS Lockbox facilities, you may elect to receive an email and/or text message notifying you that your application has been accepted. You must complete Form G-1145, E-Notification of Application/Petition Acceptance, and clip it to the first page of your application. To download a copy of Form G-1145, including the instructions, refer to www.uscis.gov "Forms."

5. If you are an applicant for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) under INA section 244, you must file this form with Form I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status. For the filing location, mail your forms according to the instructions in the recently published Federal Register notice for your country's TPS designation.

6. If you are in removal proceedings, you must file Form I-601 with the Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) office with jurisdiction over your case and according to the instructions that are provided to you in court. For information about EOIR, visit EOIR's Web site at www.usdoj.gov/eoir.
