Paperwork Reduction Act Statement. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) was signed into law on February 17, 2009, with the goal of stimulating the economy by providing billions of dollars for federal agencies to allocate through grants and loans. According to ARRA Section 1609 (c), organizations receiving grants must provide information about the environmental impact of their projects and how they comply with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Environmental Review.

To make it easy for grant recipients, like you, to provide NEPA compliance information related to your projects, HUD built the Recovery Act Management and Performance System (RAMPS).
