

Fast	Much faster downloads and uploads. It is great for music, photo sharing and watching some videos.				
Very Fast	Blazing fast downloads and uploads. It is really great for gaming, watching high-definition movies, and instantly transferring large files.

<u>Cost</u>: This is how much your household pays per month for the Internet service at your home.

<u>Speed</u>: This is the time it takes to receive (download) and send (upload) information from your home computer. Speed can be slow (similar to travelling on a San Francisco cable car at 5 mph), fast (similar to travelling on an AMTRAK train at 100 mph, or, $20 \times$ faster than *Slow*) or very fast (similar to travelling on the "bullet train" at 300 mph or, $60 \times$ faster than *Slow*).

<u>Reliability</u>: Very reliable Internet service is rarely disrupted by service outages, that is, your service may go down once or twice a year due to severe weather. With less reliable Internet service you will experience more outages, perhaps once or twice a month for no particular reason.

<u>Mobile laptop</u>: This feature allows you to use your Internet service to connect your laptop to the Internet wirelessly while away from your home. For example, you can sit on a bench in a public park and surf the World Wide Web.

<u>Cost</u>: This is how much your household pays per month for the Internet service at your home.

Speed can be slow (similar to travelling on a San Francisco cable car at 5 mph), fast (similar to travelling on an AMTRAK train at 100 mph, or, $20 \times$ faster than *Slow*) or very fast (similar to travelling on the "bullet train" at 300 mph or, $60 \times$ faster than *Slow*).

<u>Reliability</u>: Very reliable Internet service is rarely disrupted by service outages, that is, your service may go down once or twice a year due to severe weather. With less reliable Internet service you will experience more outages, perhaps once or twice a month for no particular reason.

Health: This feature allows you to use your Internet service to access your medical records over the Internet and interact with your health care providers, saving you a trip to your GP, specialist or pharmacy. For example, you can log on to your GP's web site, answer a series of questions about your symptoms, and receive an online diagnosis.
