Repayment in full by personal check or money order — (1) You can repay the overpayment by sending a check or money order, for the full amount, payable to the Railroad Retirement Board. Be sure to include your name and claim number on the check or money order.
If you send us a check, it will be converted into an electronic funds transfer (EFT). This means we will copy your check and use the account information on it to electronically debit your account for the amount of the check. The debit from your account will usually occur within 24 hours, and will be shown on your regular account statement.
You will not receive your original check back. We will destroy your original check, but we will keep the copy of it. If the EFT cannot be processed for technical reasons, you authorize us to process the copy in place of your original check. If the EFT cannot be completed because of insufficient funds, we may try to make the transfer up to 2 times.
. Credit Card — (2) You can repay the overpayment by charging the full amount to your VISA, Mastercard, DiscoverCard, or American Express card.
