### The START WITH designates the FIRST PATIENT for whom a Patient Record should be completed. The TAKE EVERY designates every patient thereafter for whom a Patient Record should be completed. For example, for a Start With of 2 and Take Every of 3, a Patient Record will be completed for the second patient listed on the clinic Sign-In Sheet and every third patient listed thereafter (e.g., 2, 5, 8, etc.). It is essential that the Take Every Number is extended each day from one Sign-In Sheet to another. For example, if your clinic uses a new Sign-In Sheet each day, then the Take Every Number has to be extended from the last patient visit selected on Monday to the new list on Tuesday. If a single Sign-In Sheet is used during the entire Reporting Period, then the Take Every Number needs to be extended as new patient names are added to the list. Patient Record should be completed. ### DEFINITIONS 1. An ambulatory patient is an individual presenting for personal health services, not currently admitted to any health care institution on the premises. **Include** patients the physician sees; and patients the physician does not see but who receive care from a physician assistant, nurse, nurse practitioner, etc. **Exclude** persons who visit only for administrative reasons, such as to complete an insurance form; patients who do not seek care or services (e.g., pick up a prescription or leave a specimen); persons currently admitted as inpatients to the hospital (**nursing home patients should be included, however**); and telephone/e-mail contacts with patients. For purposes of this study:

## 2. A *visit* is a direct, personal exchange between an ambulatory patient and a physician or hospital staff member under a physician's supervision for the purpose of seeking care and rendering personal health services.
