(DOCUMENT)

1. Board Resolution. A resolution from the PHA Board of Commissioners certifying that the flexibility will be used to facilitate “prompt, flexible, and efficient use of these funds to assist families who were receiving housing assistance immediately prior to Hurricanes Katrina or Rita and were displaced from their housing by the hurricanes.”
