Justification

Final Rule: Naturalization for Certain Persons in the U.S. Armed Forces (1615-AB85) dated January 19, 2010, amended the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) regulations by removing the requirement to submit Form G-325B, Biographic Information, with Form N-400, Application for Naturalization, for applicants applying for naturalization through service in the U.S. Armed Forces.
