

<p>The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) is requesting an amendment to its three-year clearance for the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) 2010-2011 data collections, authorized under OMB No. 1850-0582. IPEDS collects basic data from approximately 6,600 postsecondary institutions in the United States and other jurisdictions that are eligible to participate in Title IV Federal financial aid programs. All 6,600 Title IV institutions are required to respond to IPEDS (Section 490 of the Higher Education Amendments of 1992 (P.L. 102-325)). This submission requests approval for use of a new web form for a collection of directory information from non-Title IV schools that want to be part of IPEDS, small adjustment to the IPEDS Data Collection Calendar, and a reinstatement of a data collection item for the public, non-degree granting institutions. The requested change would increase the total burden time on respondents by 50 hours total, from 189,136 to 189,186.</p>
